

Havant Men's Shed

Rules:

A few obvious things, but worth stating while we have many new members and are discovering who we are:

- The Shed is tobacco, alcohol and drug free
- All times there will be Person-In-Charge, who has authority to stop and activity, exclude members or close the building
- The Shed's policy is to avoid health and safety risks to members, to visitors and to the public. Members seeing behaviour or activities which cause them concern should report them to the Person-In-Charge
- An Accident Book is in the building and all accidents should be recorded in it
- We have special responsibilities with regard to asbestos in the Shed. No work may be undertaken on, nor damage cause to, the ceiling, the external walls, the roof or panels in the internal walls without the consent of the Asbestos Officer (Andy Pottinger)
- This is an equal opportunities Shed and discrimination on grounds of differences of education, party loyalty, race, colour, orientation or age are not tolerated

The rules below have been agreed by members at their Monday meetings:

- No machinery to be used unless two adult people are present
- Members may not climb on the roof
- Powered sanding equipment must not be used within the Shed
